

TASTING NOTES ▼

This is a wine made for the open-minded, the adventurous and those who root for the underdog. It's Cabernet Franc from El Dorado California aged in used French Oak for 28 months; truly a Scrapper.

Medium deep brick red color, the mouth is coated with ripe cassis, juicy ripe black cherry and refined French oak toast backed with elegant cedar notes. The palate is also balanced with rich, sappy French oak, supple cassis and black cherry notes displayed up front, which then turn to exotic spice notes with a light dusting of cinnamon, clove and star anise, before returning to generous red fruit including a wild black raspberry finish.
