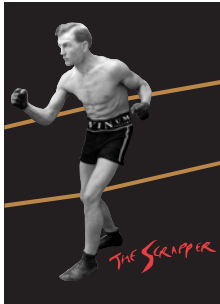

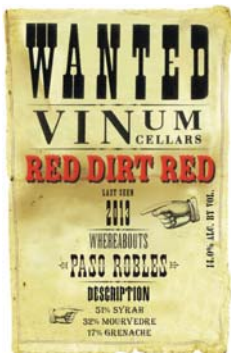
- Single Vineyard, head-pruned, and low yields.

California White Table Wine**

A unique Californian white wine made from a blend of Chenin Blanc, Roussanne and Viognier, which are barrel fermented in French Oak and aged Sur Lies for 9 months. Its cool climate pedigree stretches from Clarksburg, through San Benito to Santa Barbara County.

Paso Robles**

**[2013 THE INSIDER] Cabernet Sauvignon
Paso Robles**

Our search for quality Cabernet Sauvignon grapes brought us to Paso Robles, California, an appellation well known for producing big reds. As producers we travel directly to the source in search of the best grapes available. This relentless pursuit gives us an insider perspective.

**[NV BUBBLES] Sparkling Chenin Blanc
Clarksburg**

This is a perfect alternative to high priced Champagnes and something refreshing from the same old Prosecco and Cava the market has been flooded with. This is a fine American sparkling wine from a varietal know for making refreshing, high acid cuvees that are food friendly and versatile.

- The ONLY California Sparkling Chenin Blanc from Clarksburg.
- Barrel Fermented in French Oak.

**[2012 NAPA CAB] Cabernet Sauvignon
Napa Valley**

Medium Brick red color with rich French oak notes with ripe black cherry and cassis. The palate is ripe with light cocoa and sweet dark chocolate covered cherry notes. The palate is super concentrated and reveals a core of ripe fruit from huckleberry to plum and then back to cherry again. The cassis notes reappear on the palate and finish with soft and elegant tannins, which will allow for extended cellaring through 2030.

- Small production, 100% Napa Cab at its best.
- Dry-farmed, Hillside Vineyard with yields between 1 & 2 tons/acre.
- 24 months in 50% New French, 25% 1 year old, 25% 2 year old French Oak.
